“Frontier models made it possible for a small team like ours to build something extraordinarily ambitious,” said Richard DiBona, co-founder and CTO of Descrybe. “We’ve used OpenAI’s technology to transform a vast body of legal material into legal intelligence that AI can work with effectively. Bringing Descrybe into ChatGPT with this plugin closes that loop in a really powerful way.”

The launch reflects Descrybe’s broader vision of making sophisticated legal research available wherever people and AI systems work. Descrybe can be used through its own platform, across supported AI environments, and inside custom products and workflows through the Descrybe Open Connector and developer tools.
